This year's format will follow the previous Summer meet with our usual 50 and 100 metre events. Events are open to all age groups. Cut-off times are detailed below

Medals will be awarded for the top 6 swimmers in each age group.

We enclose full details and entry sheets and look forward to hearing from you. The closing date for entries to the gala will be 1st June 2023, or sooner should the gala become full before this date. Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis and payment is required at the point of entry.

General information and meet rules:

- 1. The competition will be held under Swim England Laws and Technical Rules.
- 2. The pool is 25m in length x 10 lanes with Omega Quantum electronic timing, scoreboard and secondary strobe will be available; anti-wave ropes will be used.
- 3. All entrants must be a member of an affiliated club and an amateur as defined by Swim England.
- 4. Age groups are 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs&over. Competition ages will be as 9th July 2023.
- 5. All events will be heat declared winners. Heats will be arranged according to submitted times.
- 6. All Clubs entering 10 or more swimmers must also provide officials. Please send a list of available to the meet organiser with your entry.
- 7. This will be a cardless meet.
- 8. Any errors must be reported to the organisers as soon as possible to allow amendments to be made. It may not be possible for amendments to made on the day of the meet.
- 9. All entries will be dealt with on a first come first serve basis. Late entries may be accepted where lane space allows and will be at the organisers discretion.
- 10. No entries will be accepted on the day.
- 11. Withdrawals will be accepted by e-mail until Saturday 8th July at 12 noon so that competitors can be removed from the start sheets. Withdrawals on the day should be notified to the timing suite.
- 12. Start sheets will be issued prior to the start of each session.
- 13. Competitors must report to the competitive stewards at the marshalling area 1 event before the event they are competing in, at which time they will be allocated to their correct lane.

 Any competitor not reporting on time may be excluded from the event.
- 14. Medals will be awarded to the first 6 swimmers in each age group.
- 15. Medal presentations will not be made. Competitors who have won an award must report to the medals table when called by the announcer.
- 16. There are no additional tolerance times. Competitors who exceed the cut-off times will not be eligible for the 6 placings awards but will receive a speeding award.



- 17. Coaches and team managers will be admitted to poolside on production of a poolside pass available for purchase prior to the event and available for collection on the day, costing £15.00 (this includes a programme and start sheets).
- 18. The referee's decision is final.
- 19. Swimmers are requested to use the changing room lockers.
- 20. No outdoor shoes must be worn on poolside; footwear must be worn outside the pool area including the spectator area.
- 21. No glass containers are permitted on the poolside.
- 22. Swimmers will be expected to maintain the appropriate social distance according to the rules in place at the time.
- 23. Spectators will be allowed at the gala but must not enter areas set aside for swimmers.
- 24. You are advised not to leave clothes or equipment lying around as neither the promoters or John Charles centre management can accept liability for loss or damage. Any lost property should be taken to the announcers table.
- 25. The promoters reserve the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator.
- 26. When entering this event, you agree that we may collect and publish personal information as part of the entry to and results of the event. We may pass such information to the Governing Body or Affiliated organisations for the purpose of membership and qualification checking. Following the event your personal information will be used for publishing results either for the event alone or combined with or compared to other events (British Rankings). The published results may include (but not limited to) Name, Club Membership, Race, Times, Age, Category
- 27. Any matter not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the organisers. Any queries should be directed to meet organiser at gala@bobsc.co.uk
- 28. Electronic entry file submission:

For everyone's convenience we will issue Electronic Entry Files for Sports Systems entry.

The Sportsys entry file information for this gala will be sent out and made available on our website no later than 60 days before the closing date.

A manual entry form may be used for clubs entering 3 swimmers or less.

The entry file and other gala information will be available for download from our website.

Please note, entry confirmation will be sent out to each club for checking before the event. A programme will be available online prior to the event.
