This year's format will follow the previous summer meets with 50m and 100m events in all strokes, and 100m IM. Events are open to all age groups. Cut-off times are detailed below

Medals will be awarded for the top 6 swimmers in each age group.

We enclose full details and entry sheets and look forward to hearing from you. The closing date for entries to the meet will be 1st June 2024, or sooner should the meet become full before this date. Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis and payment is required at the point of entry.

Coaches and team managers will be admitted to the poolside with provision of a poolside pass, priced at £10.00 each.

General information and meet rules:

- 1. The competition will be held under Swim England Laws and Technical Rules.
- 2. The pool is 25m in length x 10 lanes with Omega Quantum electronic timing, scoreboard and secondary strobe will be available; anti-wave ropes will be used.
- 3. All entrants must be a member of an affiliated club and an amateur as defined by Swim England.
- 4. Age groups are 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs&over. Competition ages will be as 14th July 2024.
- 5. All events will have two categories Girls and Boys/Open/Open. The Girls category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the Girls category you confirm that your birth sex is female.
- 6. All events will be heat declared winners. Heats will be seeded according to submitted entry times.
- 7. Late entries after the closing date may be accepted where lane-fill space allows and is at the meet organisers discretion. No entries will be accepted on the day.
- 8. Withdrawals prior to the day of the meet should be notified by e-mail so that competitors can be removed from the programme and start sheets. Withdrawals on the day should be notified to the timing suite.
- 9. Accepted entries will be confirmed to all clubs for checking prior to the meet, as it may not be possible to make changes on the day.
- 10. Start sheets will be issued to coaches and team managers prior to the start of each session.
- 11. A programme will be published online prior to the meet. Results will be published on the day of the meet.
- 12. Competitors must report to the stewards in the marshalling area, ideally 1 event before the event they are competing in, and at which time they will be allocated to their correct lane.

 Any competitor not reporting to marshalling on time may be excluded from the event.
- 13. Medals will be awarded to the first 6 swimmers in each age group in each category.
- 14. Medal presentations will not be made. Competitors who have won an award must report to the medals table when called by the announcer.



- 15. There are no additional tolerance times. Competitors who exceed the cut-off times will not be eligible for the top 6 placing awards but will receive a speeding award.
- 16. Coaches and team managers will be admitted to poolside on production of a poolside pass available for purchase prior to the event and available for collection on the day, costing £10.00
- 17. The referee's decision on all events is final.
- 18. Swimmers are requested to use the changing room lockers and only bring essential items onto the poolside.
- 19. No outdoor shoes must be worn on poolside; footwear must be worn outside the pool area including the spectator area.
- 20. No glass containers are permitted on the poolside.
- 21. Spectators will be allowed at the meet, but must not enter onto the poolside area or into any seating area that has been designated for swimmers.
- 22. Clubs entering 10 swimmers or more are requested to provide officials if possible. A copy of the BOBSC Expenses Policy will be made to all officials are the point of invitation to allow an informed decision to be made on whether to volunteer.
- 23. All visitors are advised not to leave clothes or equipment lying around as neither the promoters or John Charles centre management can accept liability for loss or damage. Any lost property found at the meet should be taken to the announcers table.
- 24. The promoters reserve the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator.
- 25. When entering this event, you agree that we may collect and publish personal information as part of the entry to and results of the event. We may pass such information to the Governing Body or Affiliated organisations for the purpose of membership and qualification checking. Following the event your personal information will be used for publishing results either for the event alone or combined with or compared to other events (British Rankings). The published results may include (but not limited to) Name, Club Membership, Race, Times, Age, Category
