



BOBSC - CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS 2022

LICENSED LEVEL 4 MEET (Licence Number TBC)

The Club Championships for Borough of Barnsley Swimming Club will be swum over four galas during 2022 at the Dearneside Leisure Centre in Goldthorpe.

Gala 1 - Sunday 11th September

Gala 2 – Friday 28th October

Gala 3 - Sunday 30th October

Gala 4 - Sunday 20th November

The championships will be run under Swim England law governing the sport and under the club's rules for the definition of swimmer categories.

The Club Championships are an annual event open only to swimmers of the Borough of Barnsley Swimming Club to allow them to compete against their peers, to gain licenced times and to win trophies and medals for their swimming. All swimmers within the Club who have joined the club and are Members (i.e. who are licensed by Swim England) are invited to swim.

The Club Championships have been a part of the Borough of Barnsley Swimming Club since its inception in 1990 when the Barnsley Metropolitan Swimming Club and Barnsley Olympic Swimming Club amalgamated. The Club still holds records of all the winners since that time and maintains the Club Championship Records for each discipline, by age group and gender for each event.

Events are split based on gender and age. Age is defined as 'age at the date of the final gala' (ie. age as at 20th November 2022)

The events available are as follows:

	Age 12 Years & Under	Aged 13 Years & Over
50m	All 4 strokes	All 4 strokes
100m	Maximum of 2 strokes plus 100m Individual Medley	All 4 strokes (not eligible for 100m IM)

Medals will be awarded for places 1-3 in each event, in each gender, and each of the age categories as outlined below:

	Age
50m all strokes	7 & Under, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15/16, 17 & Over
100m all strokes	8 & Under, 9/10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15/16, 17 & Over
100m IM	8 & Under, 9/10, 11/12
200m all strokes	13, 14, 15/16, 17 & Over
200m IM	13, 14 & Over
400m	10 & Under, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16, 17 & Over



Results will be published after each gala is complete.

Medals will be presented at the annual presentation night.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Start time for events in Sessions 1, 3 and 4: Warm up start 2.15pm. Racing Start 2.45pm

Start time for events in Session 2: Warm up start 6.00pm. Racing start 6.30pm

Swimmers should arrive 15 minutes before the warm-up start time to be ready on poolside and complete their pre-pool stretching.

Changing rooms will be available for use before and after each session, however swimmers are requested to arrive 'pool ready' in their swimwear if possible.

For any event where less than 3 competitors are entered, the organisers reserve the right to combine the event with that same event for the opposite gender and have both males and females competing in a heat together. The event results will still be separated out by boy/girl.

The lead referee's decision on all events is final.

400m Handicap

Events 203 and 204 will double as a regular 400m freestyle event, and also as a 400m handicap event. Handicaps will be applied by a series of calculations based on a swimmer's 50m freestyle time, their age and their 400m freestyle time. This is an established formula, used specifically for this event. The organiser's decision on the result will not be entered into and is final.

On the day:

No outdoor shoes must be worn on poolside.

No glass containers are permitted on the poolside.

Swimmers are advised not to leave clothes or equipment lying around as the organisers cannot accept liability for loss or damage. Any lost property should be taken to reception.

Method of gala entry:

Entries are to be submitted via the club's Swim Manager system.

The closing date for all entries is **Friday 26th August 2022.**

Late entries will not be accepted.

If a swimmer is a dual club swimmer (ie. they are registered to swim for another Club as well as Borough of Barnsley) and Borough of Barnsley is not their Ranked Club, then they may enter the



Club Championships but may swim for time only. A swimmer may only win a medal or trophy if Borough of Barnsley is their primary club.

When entering this event, you agree that we may collect and publish personal information as part of the entry to and results of the event. We may pass such information to the Governing Body or Affiliated Organisations for the purpose of membership and qualification checking. Following the event your personal information will be used for publishing results either for the event alone or combined with or compared to other events (British Rankings). The published results may include (but not limited to) Name, Club Membership, Race, Times, Age, Category

The organisers reserve the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator.

New members joining after the closing date:

When a swimmer becomes a full member after the closing date, they will be allowed to enter the next available gala by submitting an entry 2 weeks prior to the next gala date. The swimmer must have paid the necessary membership fees/subscriptions prior to the next scheduled Club Championship gala.

Withdrawals

To avoid there being empty lanes, and so that the poolside team and officials can be made aware, swimmers wishing to withdraw after entry must notify the club secretary as soon as possible before the gala – withdrawals are to be emailed to communications@bobsc.co.uk
